Correct Answer: "D" (will get) **Explanation:** here we have a Conditional sentence and it must be the fisrt Conditional sentence used to express likely future events or possibilities, often used in advice, warning and plans.

The structure of 1st conditional sentence is: if + present simple, will + base verb.

Correct Answer: "C" (was repaired) **Explanation:** here we have two verbs , the auxiliar verbs which is the verbto be in past (was) and the base or mean verb to repair , also in past (repaired) , but this sentence is in passive voice, because it foccus more in object than in subject , in other words, the object received the action practiced by the subject .

19- Why is the dog ...like that? Something strange is happening.

Correct Answer: "A" (barking) **Explanation:** the function of dog is to bark , and we again have the case of continuous tense , we have the auxiliar verb to be in present, then after base verb (to bark) we have + ing , so the sentence is in present continuous due to the cojugation of auxiliar verb in present and so on..

20- Covid-19 ...a lot of people in 2020.

Correct Answer: "B" (killed) **Explanation:** the verb is in past simple being obe of regulars verbs and Consequently the sentence is in past, even because in real situations its happened in past not in present.

21- Did the policeman ... you which way to go?

Correct Answer: "C" (tell) **Explanation:** The verb "tell" fits here because it means to give information or instructions.

The auxiliary verb "did" puts the sentence in the past simple tense, so the main verb must be in its base form tell, not told or tells, even if we are talking about the police which is in 3rd person of Singular.

22-The traffic light is red. You ...stop.

Correct Answer: "B" (must)**Explanation:** "Must" is a modal verb used to express obligation or necessity, So when the traffic light is red, it's a legal and safety requirement to stop that's why "must" fits perfectly.

23. We are teaching ... to build a house.

Correct Answer: "C" (ourselves) **Explanation**: here we have one more case of reflexive pronouns, we = our = Ourselves, usually used when the subject and object are the same.

24-We decided to waituntil John arrived. He was too late.

Correct Answer: "C" (patiently) **Explanation:** this is the correct adverb of manner, because it describes how were they waiting for John , even when he was too late , and there's no sense in saying , we decided to wait dangerously, or nervously until John arrived.

25 - I can't stop laughing. I from the bike in such a funny way.

Correct Answer: "A" (fell down) **Explanation:** is the only option that makes sense in this context.

It describes a physical action that could be funny like slipping or tumbling off the bike.

Correct Answer: "A" (Advised), **Explanation:** the sentence describes a medical recommendation, the verb to Advice means to recommend or suggest something helpfull, specially in profissional context like this, when the doctor give instructions.

Correct Answer: "C" (was built) **Explanation:** we again have the passive voice the sentence foccus more in object than subject that's why the sentence is in passive voice.

Correct Answer: "B" (itself), **Explanation:** the name dog is in third person singular, "It" and this pronoum is used to describe animals and objects, but as the sentence foccus in reflexive pronouns, we will have itself, because the action happened to object which is the same subject.

Correct Answer: "B" (doesn't it), **Explanation:** In that sentence we have a tag questions, where we usually have questions tag in the end of a sentence, to confirm ,check or ask for agreement, and if the statements is negative, the questions tag will be positive and viceverse.

The tag questions is expressed by adding negative form in auxiliar verb (to have, to do, to be)

If the statements is positive ,then the pronoum is added.
