I. Questions 1 to 5 are based on the following text.

**Childhood diseases**

**Chicken pox** is a highly contagious illness caused by primary infection. If you have chicken pox as a child you will be immune for the rest of your life. Symptoms include: red, quite itchy, spots or blister which are scattered over the entire body and also a moderate fever. Calamine is used to reduce itching. The disease is contagious from a few days before it breaks out and no more than six days after the first spots appear. The child should be excluded from school during this time. It can be treated by antiviral medicine in serious cases.

**Whooping cough** is characterised by long fits of coughing followed by wheezy breathing and possibly vomiting. Symptoms are typically worse at night. The disease is especially contagious during the first week, while the child still has a trace of a cold. The infectiousness does, however, wear off in the following five to seven weeks. It is important to keep children infected away from other children under the age of one year. Children should be excluded from school five days after starting antibiotic treatment. Treatment: fresh air is important because of the risk of vomiting; the children should eat small meals more often, instead of a few large ones.

**II. Questions 6 to 10 are based on the following text.**

Since the adoption of a new constitution in 1990, Mozambique has seen its media sector grow both broad and deep. Private media outlets have proliferated. State-run media have worked to adopt a public service format, and community radio stations serve rural areas.

Several new newspapers have established themselves in the market. Private broadcast companies have been gaining in economic strength and visibility, and begun the process of setting up offices and repeater in the provinces. In general, private media cover the provincial capitals, with the exception of private television stations.

Mozambique has one state-controlled television station, the *Televisão de Moçambique (TVM)*, broadcasting from Maputo and covering mostly urban areas in the country in Portuguese, but with some airtime allocated to local languages in some provinces. Some other television stations are based in Maputo and broadcast throughout the country. The large media companies, such as *Miramar Television* and *STV*, have provincial offices but broadcast mainly from their headquarters in Maputo, reaching the rest of Mozambique through repeater transmitters and fiberoptic cable. There is a multiplicity of media in Mozambique, from newspapers to radio and television stations to digital media.

Radio, particularly public radio, is the most accessible medium, as it is relatively cheap and it broadcasts in various local languages. Much of Mozambique's territory is covered by Radio Mozambique, though rural areas are more closely tied to community radio stations. From its Maputo headquarters, it broadcasts a national channel, a sports channel, a "City Radio" channel for young people and an English language channel.
